Minute Summary for 2 May 2012

01. Evening Prayer opened and closed the meeting
02. The article, Ritual Formation, Silence reinforced our practice of the importance of silence for meditation, “to let it all sink in and have an effect on us.”
03. The painted sticks arrangement gave another dimension to the area. The five symbols used in the bulletin each week during Lent were noted.
04. The T-bar with ribbons at the Baptismal Font drew attention to the font for the Easter Season. The lilies were from our new supplier, Krueger Wholesale Florist.
05. Ideas were discussed about using summer color fabrics Summer Ordinary Time.
06. A subcommittee of the Catholic Education Formation Committee is writing a curriculum on stewardship in Religious Education Classes through Grade 9 for next year. A draft was reviewed by the Sacred Worship Committee.
07. Regarding the parish budget, Father said we are holding our own.
08. During the months of June and July, we will be using the Mass of Glory. In August through October, we will be using the Mass of Angels and Saints with its updates.
09. Jeanette Engebretson will retire from her salaried position of Principle Accompanist June. She will continue to play for liturgy as needed. She has served the parish for 46 years.
10. The Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated in the parishes of the Wausau Deanery on the third week of May and the third week in October, a permanent schedule. The Catholic Education/Formation Committee is recommending the Friday in May.
11. It was suggested that a printed copy of the Nicene Creed inserted into the hymnals. The other responses are coming along fine.
